

Frequently Asked Questions

1) Breakfast/Lunch Prices will be the same and should be paid on My Payments Plus.

Breakfast will be grab and go on their way to the classrooms and lunches will be delivered to them in the classrooms. A google document will be online weekly for you to choose your child's lunch or let us know they will bring their lunch.

2) Mask are requested to enter/exit the building by all students, but mandatory for 3rd grade.

3) There will be no transportation changes made unless it is an emergency due to bus capacity and car line length.

4) Children will unload a bus or a car and be directed by school personnel to their classrooms. The teacher will meet them at the door and greet them along with taking their temperature and screening.

5) Recesses will be 10 minutes in length with their (static family members/classmates) and teacher. There will be one in the morning and one in the afternoon.

6) There will be no field trips at this time.

7) Only employees of St Tammany Parish school system may enter any buildings other than the office area to check in/out children.

8) Once there is a morning bell, there will be a staff member out front who will radio the office to let them know your child has arrived. He/she will be taken to the classroom. This will be a difficult process, so please be on time if at all possible.

9) Make sure your child **does not forget** needed items. We will not be able to take items to your child during the school day.

10) All conferences with our teachers will be done through virtual methods (face time/google meet/zoom). Email your child's teacher for all conference request. Make sure your child's teacher has your correct phone number and email address. This will be so important this year!

11) If your child is sick, please do not send them to school. We will continue to monitor your child's health so we may notify you if they become ill. Please keep your phone closely monitored.

12) Label your child's belongings. Book bag, jackets, sweaters, lunch bags, pencil boxes, colors, and etc. with a black permanent marker
