Title: Abita at Work! Learning About our School!

August 6, 2017

What will you teach parents so they can help to improve their student's academic performance? Parents and students will join the faculty and staff before school starts to learn about our school policies, procedures, teacher expectations, parental involvement activities, Title 1 plan, Title 1 compacts, and curriculum.

Title: Literacy Night Kindergarten and 1st Grades

September 12, 2017

What will you teach parents/families to improve their student's academic performance? Parents will learn to use literary experiences to promote comprehension, text based evidence, vocabulary development, and inferencing by engaging in activities in the classroom.

Title: Pre-K Math Parent Meeting

October 30, 2017

What will the parents learn during this activity to improve their student's academic performance? Parents will attend a meeting about how to teach math every day to your preschooler. Pre-K teachers will teach parents different methods for teaching basic math skills while keeping it fun. Parents will then go to the classrooms and create a "Make and Take" for the parents to take and use.

Title: Literacy Night 2nd and 3rd Grades

November 14, 2017

What will you teach parents/families to improve their student's academic performance? Parents will learn to engage their child in science by participating in stations to explore scientific tools, measurement, and the scientific method through hands on experiences.

Title: STEM Night Kindergarten and 1st Grades

January 9, 2018

What will you teach parents/families to improve their student's academic performance? Parents will learn to engage their child in math and Science. Teachers will have stations for parents and students to complete Math and Science STEM activities together that they will be able to extend at home.

Title: Pre-K Early Literacy Parent Meeting

February 2018

What will the parents learn during this activity to improve their student's academic performance? Parents will meet with Mrs. Holliday (TRT) and Pre-K teachers to discuss ways to help their child practice early literacy skills at home and in everyday life. Teachers then invite parents to their classrooms to create a "Make and Take" literacy activity for the children to do at home.

March 2018

May 2018
